FALL 2010 UAB MATH TALENT SEARCH REPORT

The 9-th annual UAB MTS (Math Talent Search) Contest took place on campus on Saturday, November 13, 2010.

Students began arriving at the Campbell Hall at 8:00 a.m. There were 171 students, grades 10, 11, and 12, from 13 high schools participating. With coaches and chaperones, we had a crowd of around 200 people. Students and guests were treated to cookies and cold drinks as they waited for the contest to begin.

At 9:00 a.m. students began the two hour test which was held in Business and Engineering Complex, and their teachers and chaperones enjoyed the hospitality room.

At 11:00, when the test was over, students and teachers were treated to pizza. The UAB math faculty and students began the challenging task of grading and judging the answers of the 171 students. The graders did an excellent job of determining winners. By 12:45pm the outcome of the contest was decided.

The Awards Ceremony began at 1pm with prizes presented by Dr Blokh as Dr Mayer read the list of winners. Schools who won the contest received trophies while the student winners received certificates and books about mathematics. The competition was rather tight, in particular we had a few ties. We also awarded a few Honorable Mentions as there were several students who came rather close to getting prizes but missed them by just few points.
