

FALL 2015 UAB MATH TALENT SEARCH REPORT

The 14-th annual UAB MTS (Math Talent Search) Contest took place on campus on Saturday, October 31, 2014.

Students began arriving at the Business and Engineering Complex at 8:00 a.m. There were 150 students, grades 10, 11, and 12, from 9 schools participating. With coaches and chaperons, we had a crowd of around 170 people. Students and guests were treated to cookies and cold drinks as they waited for the contest to begin.

At 9:00 a.m. students began the two hour test, and their teachers and chaperons enjoyed the hospitality room.

At 11:00, when the test was over, students and teachers were treated to pizza. The UAB math faculty and students began the challenging task of grading and judging the answers of the 150 students. The graders did an excellent job of determining winners. By 12:59pm the outcome of the contest was decided.

The Awards Ceremony began at 1pm. Various prizes were presented to winners by Dr Blokh as Dr Weikard read the list of winners. Schools who won the contest received trophies while the student winners received certificates and books about mathematics.
