The 12-th annual UAB MTS (Math Talent Search) Contest took place on campus on Saturday, October 19, 2013.

Students began arriving at the Business and Engineering Complex at 8:00 a.m. There were 131 students, grades 10, 11, and 12, from 8 schools participating. With coaches and chaperons, we had a crowd of around 150 people. Students and guests were treated to cookies and cold drinks as they waited for the contest to begin.
