- <u>Objectives</u>: Learn the fundamental postulates and framework for quantum mechanics and apply them to one dimensional examples.
- Prerequisites:

Math: courses on integral and differential calculus, and rudimentary knowledge of vectors, matrices and linear algebra. Physics: courses on modern physics and classical mechanics.

Graduate students enrolled in PH550 are assumed to have had more exposure to introductory physics concepts and are expected to utilize this in answering homework and exam questions. This expectation is reflected in the assignment of partial credit on exams and homework. When comparing scores on exams and homework with undergraduates enrolled in PH450, student should keep this difference in mind.
